## Profile

Anna Barth is a freelance dancer, teacher and artistic director of the "DanceArt Laboratory Berlin". She studied Modern Dance, Improvisation and Composition with Alwin Nicolais & Murray Louis in New York City and from 1994 - 1999 Butoh with Kazuo Ohno & Yoshito Ohno in Kamihoshikawa, Yokohama, Japan. At the intersection of Improvisation+Butch she has developed a dance-work she calls "Dance Concrete", which is grounded in constant research of the intertwining of existential realities and possibilities of the body and it's memory. Anna Barth works as a Solo-Dancer as well as in various collaborations within different constellations. With her own group she has been creating a numbers of site-specific performances, including a long-durational performance of 12 hours, using unusual out-side + in-side spaces.
